Seminars on prayer: Back to Basics Back to God

Profile for facilitator of seminars on prayer

- Be a born-again Christian.
- Be recommended by your local Church.
- Have a good theological foundation.
- Have experience in Bible teaching and speaking in public.
- Respect and adhere to our Confession of Faith and become a member of our Association.
- Attend a seminar on prayer (6 hours)
- Attend training sessions organized by “Back to Basics” for potential candidates.
- Teach 50% of the first seminar with another person.
- When teaching the seminar, emphasis the main points: Prayer in the Bible, praying about the attributes of God, prayer in the local Church.
- During the seminar, maintain a balance between Bible teaching, group discussion and praying.
- Use the tools prepared by “Back to Basics”: Preparation materials for seminars, manuals power points – films – videos, etc.
- Finances: Each seminar should cover all costs incurred. Travel costs for the facilitator would be covered. A contribution will be made to the facilitator by “Back to Basics” for each seminar.
- The week after the seminar, the facilitator will make a written report concerning the seminar: number attended – evaluation of participants – strong points – weak points – How to improve the next seminar – finances.
- A short contract with agreement will be signed by the facilitator and “Back to Basics” before the candidate begins to teach the seminars.
